

Approximately 120 current facilities may be affected by Minnesota's new cumulative impacts law

As of September 6, 2023

Using the Minnesota Legislature's criteria for an environmental justice area and the types of air permits subject to the new cumulative impacts law, approximately 123 current facilities may need additional environmental analysis when seeking an amended or reissued air permit.

Sixty-eight (68) facilities have permits that expire every five years and would be immediately affected once cumulative impacts regulations are adopted in late 2026. Fifty-five (55) facilities have non-expiring permits and would only be required to possibly undergo additional environmental analysis if they proposed changes to their permit, the MPCA required changes because of an enforcement action, or the state or federal government required changes due to new regulations.

The criteria and process to determine if a facility needs additional environmental analysis have not been created. The cumulative impacts analysis criteria and process will be developed between October 2023 and April 2026 and after extensive, active public participation.
